#### Dementia respite grants

- Age Well offers respite grants to family members and other unpaid primary caregivers who provide in-home, day-to day care for a person who has been diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease or another memory disorder and who meets certain financial criteria. These funds can be used to provide in-home respite services (home care or chore services, personal care, companion services) or out-of-home respite services (adult day programs and short-term stays in residential care facilities or nursing homes). Call the Helpline: 1-800-642-5119 for more information.
- Home Instead and the Hilarity for Charity Foundation also have a Dementia Care Relief Grant program. This provides three grant levels of in-home care through local Home Instead offices: 25 hours per week for a year, 15 hours per week for a year or a one-time 25 hour grant. #### Long-Term Care

Frail or disabled adults who medically and financially qualify for nursing home level of care may be eligible for Choices for Care, Vermont's Long-Term Care Medicaid Program. This program provides individuals with a choice of settings in which to receive care: a nursing home, residential care home or in-home support. In-home supports include care & service coordination, personal care (e.g., help with bathing or dressing), respite care, adult day health center services, assistive devices and home modification. Choices for Care-Moderate Needs can provide assistance with adult day and some homemaker services. 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### Veterans Directed Program

This program is designed for military veterans seeking an alternative to nursing home care and helps them receive in-home assistance and support so they can remain in their homes. It is a statewide collaboration between the Veterans Administration and Area Agencies on Aging. There is no income eligibility, but veterans must need a defined level of care.
