# 18-MONTH STATE CAPACITY ASSESSMENT RESULTS

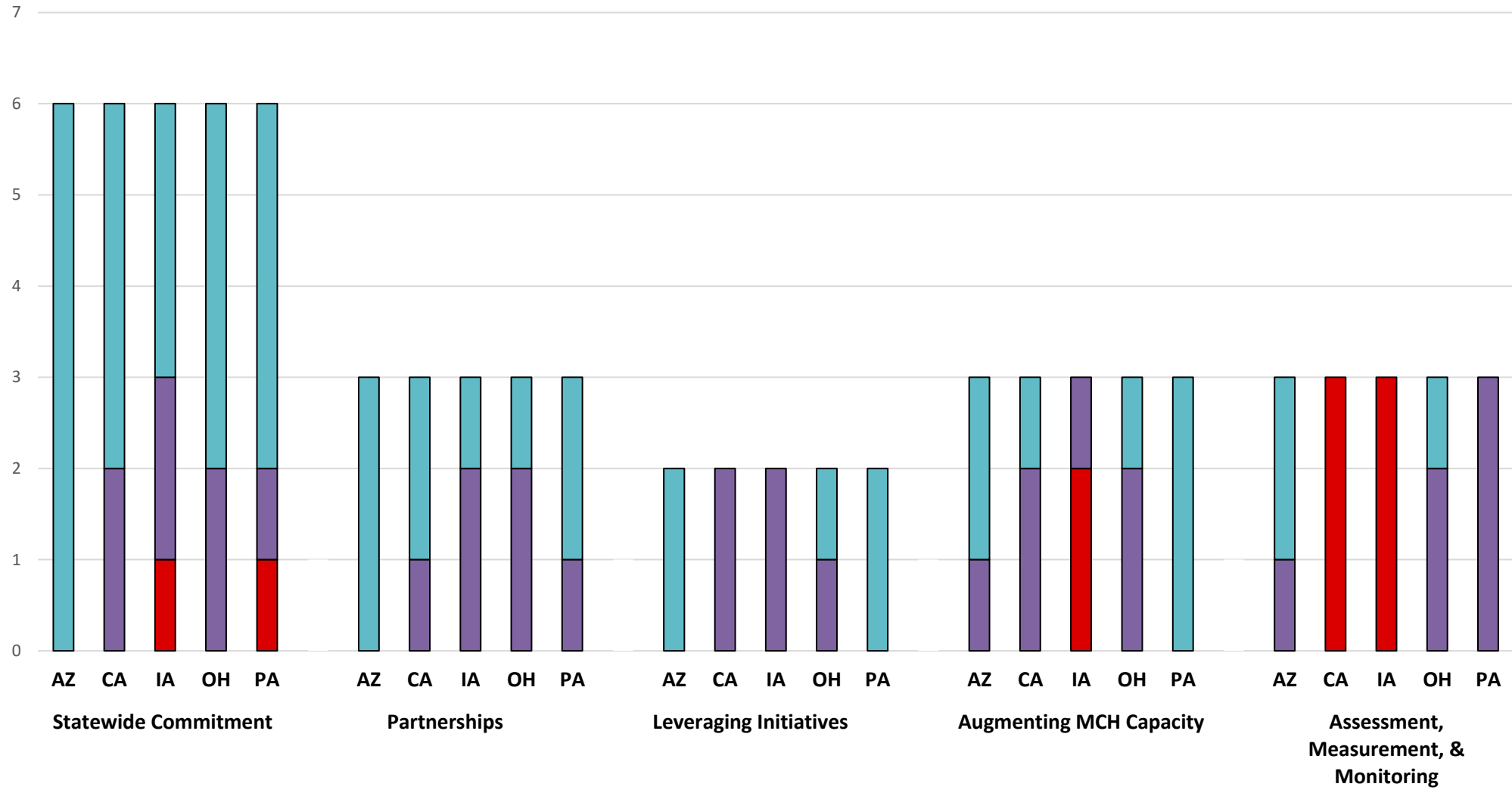
# 18 MOS: Capacity of CoIN State Teams to Address AYA MH

Implementation status of policy/procedure that leads to increased state capacity.

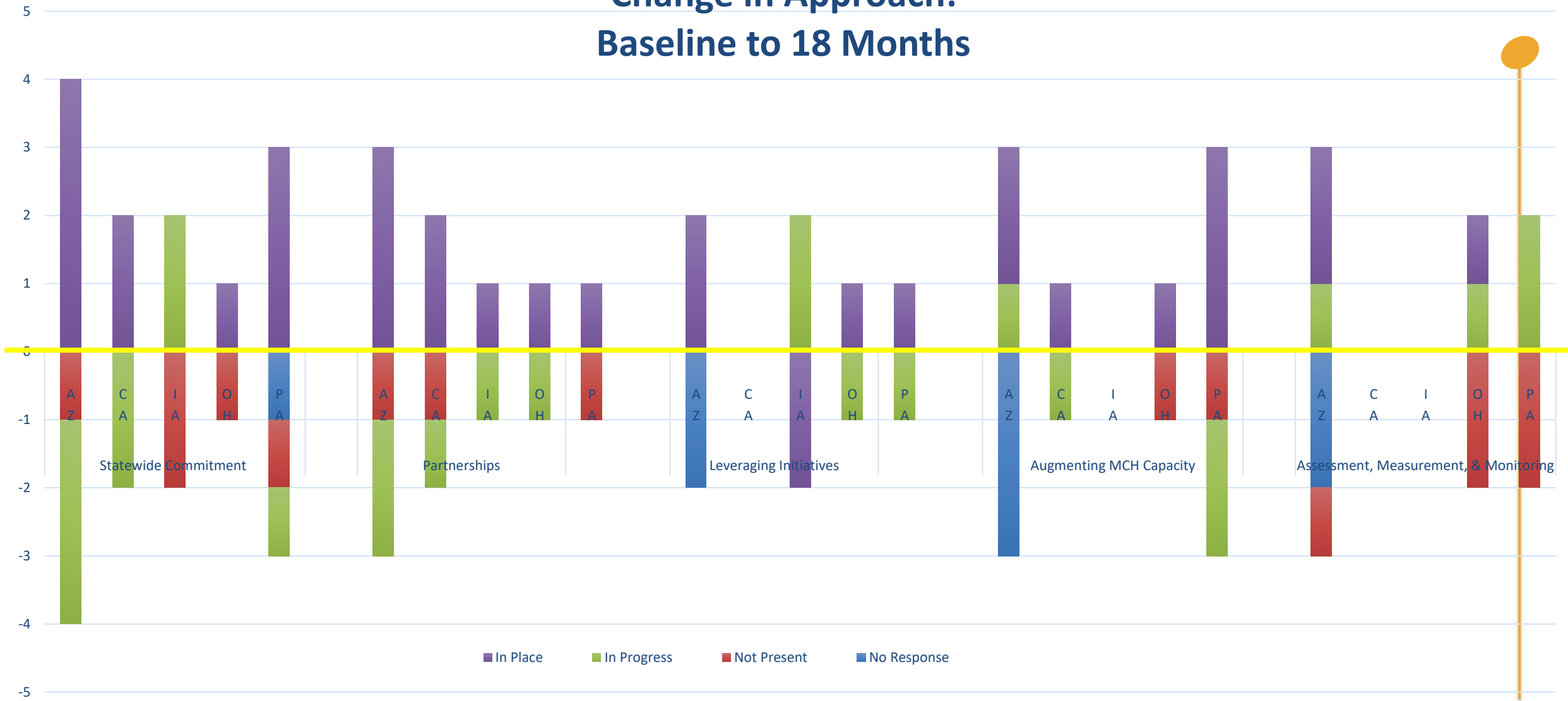
- In Place
