

Dear co2022,

Welcome to the start of your clerkship year! I want to share some information about the process of evaluating the Orientation Bridge next week. The evaluation will be in Oasis, but the process will be a bit different from what you are used to from Foundations.

- **IMPORTANT:** The evaluation is a single questionnaire that contains all of the questions for the sessions during the **entire week**. It will be opening at the beginning of the week so that you can fill it out progressively. Please make sure to wait until a session has occurred to evaluate it, and please **do not submit** your evaluation until Bridge Week is finished and all your sessions and the final questions are filled out.
- There are 3 questions about each session. Please only fill out session evaluations about sessions that you attended/completed. I understand that most of the sessions are not live, so please answer the questions accordingly.
- There will be a few questions about the Bridge overall at the end of the evaluation that are **required**.
- Bridge evaluations need to be submitted within **2 weeks** after the end of the Bridge week. Bridge evaluations are considered end-of-course evaluations and are **required**. Therefore, in line with [Policy 550](#), failure to submit an evaluation about the Bridge week will result in professionalism concerns.

For Orientation Bridge, evaluations will close on **Friday, 5/8 at 11:59pm**.
