A few important notices as you prepare to begin your clerkship year:

**UVMMC Pagers:**

UVMMC students will need pagers for some of their rotations. All students at UVMMC have been assigned a pager, which has been placed in their Given mailbox. Your pager number is available in Oasis and [we've provided you with pager encryption instructions](#). Pagers will need to be activated by calling 802-847-1414. Please read through our [Student Pager Policy](#), and [sign the attestation form](#) attesting that you have received a pager and read the policy. Please [send this form back](#) to me by **Friday, July 17<sup>th</sup>**.

**UVMMC Lockers:**

All clerkship students will have access to a hospital locker. Your locker number and combination code can be found in Oasis. UVMMC lockers are located in Baird ([Baird Lockers map](#)). Please reach out directly to me with any questions about your lockers.

Instructions to open you locker: Turn RIGHT two turns, stop at # [first number]. Turn LEFT a full turn past [second number], stop at [second number]. Turn RIGHT and pull shackle at [third number].

**UVMMC Parking:**

UVMMC students are able to purchase yellow commuter passes via the [online system](#). This will allow students to park in the Beaumont lot. Overflow parking will be in the Given lot (medical students are only permitted to park in Given if Beaumont is full).
