Subject: On Behalf of Senior Associate Dean for Medical Education Zehle: Announcing Interim Assistant Deans for Admissions

Dear Larner Community,

It is with great pleasure that I announce the appointment of Raiel Barlow, M.D., and Laura Greene, M.D., as Interim Assistant Deans for Admissions, effective August 15, 2020. In these new roles, Drs. Barlow and Greene will report to Interim Associate Dean of Admissions Nathalie Feldman, M.D., and will provide leadership support for the recruitment and selection of LCOM medical students.

Dr. Barlow has been involved in medical admissions at the College since 2012, first as a member of the Admissions Committee and then serving as Co-Vice Chair of that committee since 2015. She received her M.D. from the Larner College of Medicine in 2007. Dr. Barlow then completed an internship at UVM Medical Center, and a residency in physical medicine and rehabilitation medicine at Boston Medical Center, where she was chief resident. She joined the UVM faculty in 2011 and is now Assistant Professor of Orthopaedics and Rehabilitation.

Dr. Greene started with the Office of Admissions in 2013 as a faculty interviewer. She then joined the Admissions Committee in 2014 and since 2015 has served as Co-Vice Chair of the committee. She received her medical degree from the Larner College of Medicine in 2000, and then completed a residency in anatomic and clinical pathology at UVM Medical Center, where she was chief resident, followed by a one-year fellowship in dermatopathology. She joined the UVM faculty in 2006 and is now Associate Professor of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine.

Both Dr. Barlow and Dr. Greene have been involved in developing Multiple Mini Interview (MMI) to assess applicants to our College, a modality that has given the College a more complete and less biased view of our applicants, which has aided the process of recruiting a more diverse student body. This work has been presented nationally and has become a model for other medical schools.

Please join me in thanking Dr. Barlow and Dr. Greene for their involvement in our LCOM Admissions process and welcoming them to their new roles as Interim Assistant Deans for Admissions.
