Minutes

- **Fall Updates – Dr. Zehle**

- Pre-clinical curriculum – in person activities for one class at a time. Co2023 on campus 2 days/week and co2024 on campus 3 days/week. On “off” days, students will participate in remote learning. Pre-clinical students will continue with hybrid model of learning after Thanksgiving, unlike the undergraduate students. Currently looking into an option to make Convergence fully remote.
- Added wellness day to orientation to replace the ropes course activity
- Pre-arrival testing will apply to the class of 2023 and 2024. Advocating that the other classes not participate in the at-home testing since they have been in the clinical environment for a significant time period
 - **After subsequent discussion, all students will participate in the UVM COVID-19 student testing protocol
- All medical students will additionally participate in surveillance testing once a week. There will be an app coming soon for tracking results.
- School and Room Access: Developing room reservation platform instructions. This will help deter students from clogging hallways to search for empty and unused rooms. Library instructions have been established with accommodation of up to 75 people.
- Campus Updates: The west palm beach campus will be closed. The LIC health network will not be available likely for a few years
- Should we continue Wednesday Wonders?
 - The volume of information that is being disseminated has decreased, however students are still interested in learning about clinical updates from the hospital.
 - They also appreciate the administrative updates regarding testing
 - Plan to make this a biweekly email to students
- GQ results finally completed. Response rates were above the national average. Highlights and pertinent information will be included for a presentation to the LCME Task Force on Monday

- **Scholarly Projects – Leigh Ann**

- Propose to add learning about the research process into SEG meetings. This would include topics such as how to make a poster, how to write a research question, what makes an interesting research topic, how do we test our ideas, etc. Leigh Ann seeking input about what we as a group want to learn about research in general and the research process.
- Goal would be to make scholarly projects more approachable.

- **Project Updates**

- Exam Review Proposal – will be presenting next week at Foundations meeting. Anna and Will looking for advice regarding remote FoCS exam review. In the current system, students will not have access to the exam after taking it. Given that there is not one specific professor who writes FoCS exam questions, there is no one person capable of clarifying the majority of questions in an exam review.
- SEG Communications – Raj looking for feedback about what information SEG would like to display on our commons page for student access.

- Will now be collecting monthly accomplishments on project tracker to help compile a list for the “you said, we did” column in the weekly wire
