## Minutes

- **Welcome New Committee Reps**
- **Guest Dr. Feldman (Honor Code)**
  - Learning Environment, Code of Conduct, and other policies being modified to align with the new professionalism statement
  - Student honor code policy statement will now include a link to the statement on medical professionalism
  - Orientation Honor Code Statement
    - Dr. Feldman to follow up with the orientation committee to see what will be included in this presentation for the incoming class of 2024
    - Things to think about including:
      - How to give feedback to faculty and express yourself in a way that is heard
      - What is the role of SEG and other student leadership groups
      - What is the honor code and how does it relate to our professionalism statement
  - Class of 2023 confusion regarding the professionalism impact of uncompleted student evaluations
    - Questions to address: What are the consequences and how are these being tracked? Is there a way to make this policy more clear to students, including the incoming class? Can we expand upon the tenants of professionalism? How can we make professionalism longitudinal and consistent throughout the curriculum?
- **Guest SJC**
  - Social medicine theme of the week has transformed into an infographic format during remote learning. Themes from past years are being updated to fit the needs of our new environment and class goals.
  - Dr. Berns is revamping the PCR course to be more applicable to the physician experience. Zach and Kris will be working with Dr. Berns this summer to develop readings and other materials that incorporate social justice themes
  - SEG can help collect feedback from students regarding what is working well with PCR and what needs are not being met.
  - Thinking about incorporating SJC themes of the week into clinical student curriculum. Could do this through the weekly wire with links to podcasts or reading materials. SJC looking for more input on this.
- **Project Updates**
  - Exam review proposal
    - Anna spoke with Dr. Everse, who believed the project to be feasible
    - Professors should have the ability to link questions to objectives and have each question annotated, although this will require much work on their part
    - Anna will gauge interest from other course directors in the coming months
- **Course & Committee Updates**
- **Miscellaneous**
  - Bylaws were updated in March at the annual retreat

- Team 4: M1 role will now include management of project list, agenda, and meeting minute distribution
  - Team 3: Added LIC and the commons to roles
  - Changes unanimously accepted and approved
- Tuition concerns from students
  - Students entering clerkships are concerned that their tuition is not being represented in the curriculum they are receiving.
  - Students would like the administration to be transparent about the financial aspects of the curriculum and to specifically speak to how the budget will change and how it will impact the students

  - Raj to follow up to see what we can send out
- Step 1 Dates
  - ~30 students have not taken
  - Possible options to consider for these students:
    - Option 1: take the exam as soon as possible
    - Option 2: can enter clerkship if they have set a test date within reasonable amount of time
    - Option 3: can take the exam after clerkship if they feel like they are unable to study alongside clerkship
    - Option 4: leave of absence and join Co2023
