Dear LCOM Community,

We are pleased to announce the appointment of Justin DeAngelis, M.D. and Mariah McNamara, M.D., as Interim Assistant Deans for Students in the Office of Medical Student Education, effective March 1. Both will report to Interim Associate Dean for Students Lee Rosen, Ph.D.

As interim assistant deans, Drs. DeAngelis and McNamara will provide oversight of programs that support student professional identity development, academic achievement, health and wellbeing and career advising, and contribute to institutional leadership initiatives related to the delivery of the Larner medical education program.

Dr. DeAngelis received his medical degree from the Sidney Kimmel Medical College at Thomas Jefferson University in Philadelphia. He completed a residency in obstetrics and gynecology at Boston Medical Center. He has been a member of the UVM faculty since 2017, and is an Assistant Professor of Obstetrics, Gynecology and Reproductive Sciences. In 2020 he took on the role of Associate Clinical Clerkship Director in OBGYN. He has received numerous teaching awards, including the 2020 Association of Professors of Gynecology and Obstetrics Excellence in Teaching Award.

Dr. McNamara is a graduate of the Larner College of Medicine. In addition to her M.D. degree, she holds a Master of Public Health degree from the Harvard University School of Public Health. She completed a residency in emergency medicine at the Harvard Affiliated Emergency Medicine Program at Brigham & Women's and Massachusetts General Hospitals and was a fellow in global health at Massachusetts General Hospital. She joined the UVM faculty in 2012 and is currently an Associate Professor of Surgery in the Division of Emergency Medicine, where she is Assistant Division Chief. She is Associate Chief Medical Officer for Medical Staff Affairs at the UVM Medical Center and Associate Director of the Larner College of Medicine/Nuvance Health Global Health program. She is the recipient of the Abrams Teaching Award for dedication and commitment to excellence in education from the UVM Department of Surgery.

We are delighted to have these two outstanding members of our faculty join our Office of Medical Student Education team. Their passion for medical education and commitment to the student experience will be a tremendous asset to our medical education program. Please join us in welcoming them in their new roles.
