- **Updates with Dean Zehle**
  - LCME: Liaison Committee on Medical Education will be visiting Larner and will be graded on a set number of standards. The LCME will be visiting through Zoom on April 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup>. Following the visit a Survey Report Review is provided to the college for amendments and then one final review is reported to determine if LCOM is satisfactory and compliant. Accreditation would last for an eight-year term.

- **Megan Boyer – Vote on Bylaws**
  - Bylaws following SEG retreat were voted on and approved in the meeting. New bylaws will be posted to the WeeklyWire.
- **Anna Chamby – SEG Goals**
  - Comparison of SEG with other medical schools and presenting our findings to medical curriculum conferences.
  - Increasing SEGs roles in clerkship and finding a way to have a larger role in improving clerkship.
  - Marketing SEG better in orientation so first years understand their role and promoting what our roles are.
  - VIC 2.0 planning and what does SEGs role look like moving forward.
- **Megan Boyer – VIC 2.0 Updates**
  - Foundations Engagement Proposal and new proposed calendar discussed for presenting to the curriculum directors.
  - Discussed potential projects to focus on pre-clinical workloads and changing the curriculum timing prior to STEP 1.
  - Propose clinical skills curriculum changes to more align with the academic curriculum. Will Brown has a proposal that will be amended moving forward to bring to the clinical skills directors.

  - Metabolism Integration project to improve metabolism between NMGI and FoCS by integrating and standardizing preworks.
  - Anatomy model proposal to improve anatomy course in FoCS. There is a current discussion on locations and budgets for this proposal.
