## Minutes

- **VIC 2.0 with Dr. Lounsbury and Dr. Moore**
  - Proposals for VIC 2.0 in the work
    - 10-week summer or longitudinal Fridays
    - Extend Attacks and Defenses by 1 week and Decrease NMGI by 1 week
    - Clinical Bootcamp reworking the 2<sup>nd</sup> year to allow for changes in what information is presented before and post STEP 1.
    - Follow-up ideas:
      - Groups related to trimming specific courses alone to best maximize our efforts.
      - Changing how doctoring skills is taught to decompress with STEP 2 clinical changes.
- **Updates with Dean Zehle**
  - Discussion of STEP 1 pass/fail addressed future goals to relieve the stress around this exam to move forward. The report on this discussion with guidelines will be released June 30<sup>th</sup>.
  - Creative thinking and students' perspectives is important for VIC 2.0 which students will be involved in moving forward.
  - The retreat is approaching and having student engagement for certain sessions is ideal. Students will be asked to engage in certain sessions coming up.
- **Introductions for New Faculty Advisor for SEG: Julia O'Connor**
- **Anna Chamby: Project Tracker**
  - Raj: Student councils student leadership communication website will be launched this week.
  - Delaney and Will: Radiology Integration will start being implemented in anatomy during FoCS next year. The project is still in the works for finding ways to integrate more radiology in curriculum moving forward.
  - Delaney: Clerkship guidance document is in the works so that students are not in the dark going into clerkship.
- **Student Guidebook: Elise Prehoda**
  - Recruiting student members to be a part of the task force for updating the student's guidebook regarding the courses at LCOM.
- **Pre-work Concerns: Dan Fried and Heather Giguere**
  - Most pre-works are expected to be a 1:1 in-class to out of class ratio in expected preparatory time. This standard is currently not being met for most classes in medical neuroscience. Pre-works should have a flow of matching objectives which is also not being met.
  - Medical Neuroscience also has a lot of extra information that is beyond the scope of clinically relevant material which creates an unneeded burden on students.
  - Pre-work committee may be a proposed solution and allowing students to flag pre-works that are difficult that then are sent through this committee may streamline improving issues within pre-work.
  - Allowing students to report their difficulties may provide an empowerment to students that motivate them to provide that feedback.

- Feedback fatigue is difficult to gage, but the way feedback is being requested is not a good way to obtain the data we need to provide quality feedback.
