We are pleased to formally announce the appointment of Matthew Geeslin, M.D., M.S. Eng., as the new course director for Connections, a second-year course in the Foundations Level of the Vermont Integrated Curriculum.

Dr. Geeslin joined the UVM faculty in 2017 as an Assistant Professor of Radiology in the Division of Musculoskeletal Imaging. He received his B.S. in Biomedical Engineering, his M.S. in Mechanical Engineering, and his M.D. degree from the University of Minnesota. He completed his internal medicine internship at Wake Forest and his residency and fellowship in diagnostic radiology at the University of Virginia. Dr. Geeslin is the Director of Musculoskeletal Ultrasound and Image-guided Interventions and the Associate Vice-chair of Imaging Informatics. He is enthusiastic about medical education and is a founding co-director of the graduate course, *Human Anatomy through Medical Imaging*. He completed the Teaching Academy's Medical Education Fellowship Program and was inducted as a member in 2020.
