Good Morning UVM Medical School Staff,

We hope you are all doing well. We are writing in hopes that you could either provide us with a student list or pass information along to the first year medical school students. We would also like to schedule an in-person visit sometime in the near future if it does not interfere with any COVID-19 restrictions.

At this point in time, the Air Force is currently two months into the board cycle for our Health Professions Scholarship Program. There are a limited number of three year scholarships available for students currently in their first year of medical school. For those who are unaware; the Air Force HPSP pays 100% of the students tuition, covers all of the student's fees/books/labs/etc that is required by your school, and pays the student a \$2540 per month stipend. In exchange for the scholarship, students will incur a service commitment (1 year of service for 1 year of scholarship with a minimum of 3 years) once they complete their residency. It's a great way for our future doctors to earn their medical degree while incurring minimal student debt.
