The Graduate Writing Center offers free writing support to all UVM graduate students. Visit uvm.mywconline.net where you can choose an **in-person individual** appointment in our Howe Library ground-floor suite, a **remote individual or group appointment** via Teams, or an **Email Feedback Letter** appointment.

- Did you know? If you have a long or technical draft, you can make a two-part **Review and Meet** appointment with the same consultant. Mark the first appointment “Review,” attach or link your draft, and describe your project and concerns. You can ignore the appointment reminder you’ll receive as your consultant will spend this hour getting familiar with your project. At the same time make a second appointment (same consultant on the same or different day) and mark it “Meet.” This is the appointment you’ll attend, your consultant ready to converse!
- Did you know? We love repeat appointments! You can ask your consultant about making a **standing appointment** so that you can work with one person over time toward your goals—a great option for dissertation and thesis writers too.

Sometimes all a writer needs is dedicated and uninterrupted writing time. Our virtual **Friday Afternoon Graduate Writing Retreats** on Teams is here to help! The retreat gives graduate students extended writing time with the option of meeting with a consultant. Sign up before 3 pm Friday on our scheduling calendar to receive your Teams invite: uvm.mywconline.net. You have the choice of joining the retreat at 3 pm for check-in and goal-setting. Or join any time after 3:15 for independent writing, with the retreat wrapping up by 5:30 with closing discussion, strategy sharing, and next-steps goals.
