Dear Larner Community,

I am pleased to announce that Richard Galbraith, M.D., Ph.D., has agreed to serve as Interim Senior Associate Dean for Research (SADR) beginning July 1, 2022, when Dean Gordon Jensen retires. I was delighted to receive substantial interest, with strong candidates, for both the interim and permanent position. Dr. Galbraith will not be applying for the permanent position, allowing internal candidates to be evaluated in the formal search process for the next SADR. The search consultant is Isaacson, Miller and the search co-chairs are University Distinguished Professor and Chair of Pharmacology Mark Nelson, Ph.D., and Associate Dean for Public Health and Health Policy and Senior Advisor to the Dean Jan Carney, M.D., M.P.H.

Dr. Galbraith was appointed in 1995 as Professor of Medicine in the Larner College of Medicine. He served as Associate Dean for Patient Oriented Research from 1995 to 2012, as Associate Dean for Research from 2012 to 2014, and as Interim Senior Associate Dean for Research during 2014. From 2014 to 2020, he served as the Vice President for Research at UVM after which he served as Interim Co-Director of the UVM Cancer Center until July 2021. He brings experience not only in research administration but also from his own activities in obtaining funding for and carrying out his own clinical, translational, basic and policy-based research.

Please join me in welcoming Dr. Galbraith to his new role. Of course we will properly acknowledge Dr. Jensen's accomplishments as the date of his retirement approaches.
