I'm excited to announce two new in-person group offerings for M1's through the Peer Tutoring Program:

- **PARTS framework** *w/Dario Vanegas (co2025)* -- a small group **skills development** offering (3 per meeting) focusing on integrating core principles from the science of learning for efficient medical student session prep and review workflow (see sign up for more information). Dario is a member of the peer tutoring program and started developing this 5-step integrative framework after his M1 year, sharing this with those he tutors -- he is enthusiastic about now offering this to small groups.
