Additional Information	<p>TO: LCOM students in the classes of 2023 AND 2025</p> <p>The UVM Larner College of Medicine uses Resuscitation Quality Improvement (RQI) Program for both Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support (ACLS) and Basic Life Support (BLS) training and certification. The RQI program is fully approved by The American Heart Association.</p> <p>In the near future, you will receive an email notification from RQI 1 Stop / RQI Partners that an account has been created for you. There will be a link within the email for you to set up your account and reset your password. Once your account is created, the LCOM Class of 2023 will be enrolled in ACLS and those in the LCOM Class of 2025 will be enrolled in BLS respectively.</p> <p>After your enrollment is confirmed, you will receive a notification that a “new” assignment is available.
