Dear GSA Colleagues,

I am writing to announce a new Dermatology Residency Program. Based at Capital Regional Medical Center in Tallahassee, FL with Core Faculty from Dermatology Associates of Tallahassee, it has received initial accreditation from the ACGME as an advanced training (PGY 2-4) program and is seeking immediate applicants to begin the program in July 2022 as well as applicants for 2023. Applications should be submitted through ERAS (NRMP codes are 1587080A0 for senior students applying for 2023 start date and 1587080R0 for 2022 applicants completing preliminary training). Qualified applicants will be selected for interviews and the program also plans to participate in the Match Week Supplemental Offer and Acceptance Program (SOAP). Applicants for 2022 will need to have completed 12 months of education in fundamental clinical skills in an approved residency program in Internal Medicine, Family Medicine or Surgery by July 1, 2022 (transitional or preliminary year).

This program is part of the University of Central Florida (UCF)-HCA Healthcare GME consortium and will accept two residents per year beginning from July 2022 for a total of 6 accredited positions. The program will be directed by Stephen K. Richardson, MD, FAAD, who is a former Core Faculty member of the FSU Dermatology Residency Program. The Dermatology program will be among the first UCF-HCA GME programs at Capital Regional Medical Center and is the 29th consortium program. Capital Regional Medical Center is proud to be the area's leading health care facility in hospital safety and is part of HCA Healthcare, the nation's leading healthcare provider. In fall 2021, Capital Regional Medical Center received an 'A' for providing safe patient care by the Leapfrog group for its fifth consecutive time.
