Dear GSA Colleagues,

I am writing to announce a new Psychiatry Residency Program based at Capital Regional Medical Center in Tallahassee, FL that has received initial accreditation from the ACGME and is seeking immediate applicants to begin the program in July 2022. Applications for this four-year residency must be submitted through ERAS (the NRMP program code is 1587400C2 and ERAS site will open soon). Qualified applicants may be selected for interviews later in February and the program plans to participate in the Match Week SOAP program in March. This program is part of the University of Central Florida (UCF)-HCA Healthcare GME consortium and will accept six residents per year beginning from July 2022 for a total of 24 accredited positions.

Dr. Jeffrey Ferraro is the Program Director for the new psychiatric residency. He is currently Medical Director of Psychiatric Services at Capital Regional Medical Center and an Assistant Professor at the University of Central Florida and Assistant Clinical Professor with the Florida State University College of Medicine. He received his medical degree at Albany Medical College and was Chief Psychiatry Resident at the University of Florida. He also served as Medical Director at the Tallahassee Memorial Hospital Behavior Health Center.

Capital Regional Medical Center is proud to be the area's leading health care facility in hospital safety and is part of HCA Healthcare, the nation's leading healthcare provider.
