GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

See application for details.

Applicant must be a Vermont resident and serve Vermonters, as defined by the Program.

Must work as a nurse for a minimum average of 20 hours per week during the year of service and the required minimum weeks per year, as defined by the Program.

The practice site, region, or specialty must be a nurse workforce shortage area, as defined by the Program.

Recipient must sign a service obligation contract for a specific worksite (typically a 12-month commitment).

Grants go directly to pay educational loans.
