CARES Act funding is limited to expenses students incurred due to COVID-19 related disruption of campus operations and move to remote learning. These funds cannot be used to make up for lost wages for students or their families. CARES Act Emergency Grants do not need to be repaid. If you have incurred eligible expenses and are experiencing financial hardship, please complete the CARES Act Emergency Grant Application for consideration. Decisions and disbursements will be made as quickly as possible.
