Medical Schools,

The U.S. Dept. of Veterans Affairs (VA) is excited to offer a brand-new loan repayment program called the Specialty Education Loan Repayment Program (SELRP). SELRP provides medical residents and fellows (Eligible Specialties Below) \$40K annually, in the form of student loan repayment (maximum \$160,000) while still in training. In return the physician comes to work for the VA for 2, 3, or 4 years depending on student debt and how many years remaining in training. The commitment is year for year with a minimum of 2 years in the specialty identified below and a maximum of 4 years.

Medical students who have been MATCHED to one of the below residency programs are eligible for SELRP. Please share with final year medical students and any residency programs you may be affiliated with.
