Please see information below about this year's Step 2 CK voucher program:

Dear co2023 student,

This email is to let you know that you are pre-approved for **one** OME-purchased Step 2 CK NBME self-assessment voucher to be used to at any point as part of your Step 2 CK readiness planning. To keep the program cost sustainable, all co2023 students will be issued only one voucher for this year's program cycle. However, students are able to request a second voucher from [StudentCOMServices](#) if they determine it would be helpful for their studying.

The Medical Student Services Team has pre-issued a voucher (Step 2 CK) PDF to each co2023 student's individual Oasis account, see instructions below for accessing yours. Students are not obligated to use these, and any unused vouchers will be credited back to OME for future students to redeem. Please keep this email for reference.

Instructions for Accessing your Step 2 CK Voucher in Oasis

1. Log-in to your [OASIS](#) account at any time
2. From the "Announcements" box at the top of your 2022-23 schedule, click on "View your Academic History"
3. Select the "Academic Achievement" tab
4. See the "Practice Exam Vouchers" Section
5. You will find one unique PDF voucher assigned to you, each with instructions for redeeming an NBME practice exam (self-assessment) at any time between now and your Step 2 CK exam date! Please note that starting an NBME practice exam, whether you decide to finish it or not, equates to a voucher used.

Some Step 2 CK voucher program and planning FAQ's:

- **How many Step 2 Vouchers can I receive from OME?** The Step 2 CK voucher program this year pre-approves one OME-purchased voucher to be used optionally at any point before Step 2 CK, with a second voucher available upon request. The first of these vouchers has been uploaded to Oasis. If you decide you would like a second voucher, please send a request to [StudentCOMServices](#) at least two full business days before you expect to take your practice exam. Make sure to clarify that you are requesting a Step 2 voucher and that you have already used the voucher in Oasis. Of course, students are welcome to purchase additional vouchers from the [NBME](#) (cost is \$60/form).
- **Why only two vouchers from OME, are there extras?** Unfortunately, OME does not

have a surplus of these vouchers and the program is currently budgeted to allow for two vouchers for each student, *unless* a student is at risk for not passing Step 2 CK. Students can reach out to the Med Student Financial Services Coordinator, [Ryan Gates](#), if they would like to discuss Financial Aid options for funding additional vouchers, or preparation materials.
