### GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Applicant must be a Vermont resident.

Applicant must be employed full-time as a medical laboratory professional at a University of Vermont Health Network (UVMHN) laboratory within the state of Vermont.

Applicant must have at least an associate degree from an eligible/accredited school and be qualified as and currently working as a medical laboratory technician, medical laboratory technologist, or clinical laboratory scientist.

Recipient must sign a service obligation contract (typically a 12-month commitment) at a specified UVMHN laboratory.

Grants go directly to pay educational loans.
