Additional Information	<p>Essentially, our program is a four-year pediatric residency that entails the three “standard” years of pediatric residency in Houston, TX, as well as an additional year, usually done between the second and third year of residency, spent in one of our overseas clinical sites (including Botswana, Malawi, Uganda, Eswatini, Lesotho or Tanzania). During their year abroad our pediatrics residents primarily work in an outpatient pediatric HIV clinic, but there are also opportunities, depending on the site, for inpatient hospital work, working at rural outreach sites, and working in specific specialty areas of interest such as Hematology/Oncology.
