**The Graduate Writing Center is hiring for Fall '21-Spring '22!** If you are an experienced graduate student writer who would like to help other graduate students with their writing while you also work toward College Reading and Learning Association tutor certification, consider becoming a graduate writing consultant. Graduate writing consultants work with advanced writers across UVM's graduate degree programs and also participate in paid training and staff development. The total time commitment per week during the semester is 6 to 10 hours. Starting pay is \$15 an hour.
