Hello medical school leaders and advisors,

We wanted to make you aware of a relatively new combined program at Johns Hopkins in Emergency Medicine and Anesthesiology and ask that you keep our program in mind for student with career interests in these specialties when advising.

Our 6-year program, the first and only of its kind in the US, trains residents to be board- eligible in both specialties. Our program started in 2018 and currently has residents through our PGY5 class. Our current residents have interests in areas in which there is significant and complementary overlap, such as critical care, trauma, ultrasound, and acute pain management and regional anesthesia, as well as those who wish to develop the capabilities to provide care across the spectrum of a patient's stay in rural or austere environments.

We are excited to speak to any medical students who want more information, and have a combined away elective available through our school of medicine that can be found below with our webpage, as well as a podcast about our program. We are in ERAS as a separate program from our categorical EM and Anesthesiology programs.
