Dear Students,

Many of you have been asking about study spaces and library times. Below is our most recent updated recommendations:

1. Library

- a. Opening Monday August 17th with normal operating hours, the website will be updated shortly [Dana Library](#)
- b. Limited to 75 visitors at a time. Seating is only available in open study spaces to accommodate social distancing protocols. The small group study rooms, the classroom, and the conference room are closed, and after hours study will not be available.
- c. If a library staff member should contract COVID or be out for an extended period of days for any illness, we may need to reduce hours temporarily so that we can adequately cover open hours with a limited number of staff.

2. Study Spaces

- a. If you are not on campus, you should stay remote. We have limited space options during the week.
 - b. If you are looking for space on an "in person" day:
 - i. Given Bistro area is open (limited capacity)
 - ii. As noted in our ["Guide for Booking Med Ed Rooms"](#), students cannot reserve rooms for study time. However, as shown in the guide, you can "view rooms" in outlook to see if they are available for blocks of times/on a given day. Students are invited to use spaces that are available and do not have meeting reservations in Outlook.
 - c. Students are welcome to use any of the MedEd Complex room on weekends. Please maintain the appropriate cleaning requirements and room capacity requirements
- You will need to adhere to mask-wearing rules depending on the space in you are working.
 - ALL spaces are clearly marked regarding total capacity.
 - You will need to continue all physical distancing guidelines as well.
 - You do need to clean any space you are using after you leave it (spray bottles and towels are available in most rooms).
 - You will need you CAT card for access to the library (limited use to LCOM, CNHS and UVMCMC), so please ensure you are keeping up with the [UVM Green and Gold Promise](#) and the [UVM COVID-19 Student Testing Protocol](#) to keep your CAT card activated.
