

**PNHP Northern New England Internship on Health System Reform
Offered Remotely, Summer 2022**

The Vermont and New Hampshire chapters of Physicians for a National Health Program (PNHP) are pleased once again to announce several paid, full-time summer internships for medical students with a strong desire to augment their knowledge and leadership skills in the area of health system reform. Highly qualified health professions students will also be considered. The internship is 5 weeks long (dates TBD depending upon participants' schedules) and carries a stipend of \$1250.

Interns will evaluate the successes and failures of US and foreign systems of health care organization, guided by PNHP faculty and a distinguished group of medical, corporate, and political leaders. The goal is to enhance interns' confidence in advocating for policies likely to improve their patients' access to affordable health care.
