

## 2022 Visiting Underrepresented in Medicine Student Elective Program

## Consider an Elective at SCM

This program is designed to expose URiM students from across the country to the outstanding residency training programs offered at the OU-TU School of Community Medicine (SCM) in Tulsa, Oklahoma. During the 4-week elective students will connect and form relationships with current SCM faculty, staff and residents while obtaining hands-on clinical experience in their specialty of interest. Students will also spend time in the city of Tulsa, discover its strengths and opportunities, while learning about the SCM's unique mission to address the social and structural determinants of health outcomes within Tulsa in collaboration with our community.

## **Program Details**

- SCM accepts applications through the <u>VSAS</u> (Visiting <u>Student Application Service</u>) for full-time MS4, attending an LCME-accredited medical school or COCA-accredited osteopathic medical school seeking to take an SCM 4-week elective for credit. Rotation dates are established by SCM and noted on the VSAS SCM information page. <u>Additional information can be found here</u>. All program rotations are subject to availability.
- Accepted students must be in good standing at their home institutions, and be a member of a group that is recognized as racially/ethnically URiM by SCM:
  - Black/African-American, Hispanic/Latino, or Native/Indigenous (American Indian, Native Hawaiian, Alaskan Native, mainland Puerto Rican)
- Accepted students will receive a \$1,500 stipend to cover cost of living expenses and may be eligible for an additional stipend if traveling from outside of Tulsa.
