Good Afternoon,

I am David Dormann, Education Specialist, with the Army Medical Department. I created a webcast about the Army Reserve Medical Department and the incentives for Resident Physicians. The programs we offer incur NO active duty obligation and WILL NOT interfere with Residency Training.

Our two programs will help pay back up to \$250,000 of student loans and provide a monthly Stipend of over \$2300 to the student during residency training. The stipend is in addition to the normal pay they receive from the Hospital they are training at.

Two great programs that won't interfere with residency training and no active duty obligation. We ask that they serve in the Army Reserve as a physician, in their specialty after residency.
