Additional Information	<p>Andrea Villanti, PhD, MPH is a social and behavioral scientist who conducts research to inform public health programs and policies. Current projects address the relationship between perceptions and problems with vaping in Vermont youth and young adults (<a href="http://pacevt.org">pacevt.org</a>); the impact of COVID-19 on mental health and substance use in Vermont youth and young adults; and the potential role of nicotine corrective messaging on tobacco-related beliefs and behaviors in U.S. adults.</p> <p>The fellowship will include experience with cohort study design and management, statistical analysis of cohort and trial data, and contribution to scientific publications and presentations. Full-year or summer research fellowships possible.</p> <p>Full-year fellows (through the <a href="#">LCOM Medical Student Research Fellowship</a>) would have the opportunity to develop new research projects in ongoing and pilot studies.</p> <p><a href="#">Full-year</a> or <a href="#">summer research</a> fellowships possible.</p>
